
ADDRESS OF THE CATHOLIC BISHOP OF ENUGU DIOCESE AND THE PROPRIETOR OF GO UNIVERSITY



I praise your dedication and team spirit without which things may have turned awry since 'one tree cannot make a forest'. I praise your spirit of sacrifice because I know that what has sustained you is not the money you receive, but your desire to see sanity return to our institutions, and to see Nigeria stand on a sound footing again. May your sacrifices never go unrewarded both here and hereafter.
